

Location:

Travel information (flight & train):

The meeting will be at the Norwegian University of Life Sciences (NMBU), Ås. There is a train (train R12 towards Moss) from Oslo central station (Oslo S) to the train station in Ås every half hour. Oslo S can easily be reached by train from the airport. You can plan your yourney on the following website Vy | Train | Bus | Taxi | Book your trip at vy.no. We will arrange transportation from the train station to the venue. Please inform us about your arrival time when you register for the meeting.

On Wednesday evening after dinner, we will arrange transportation to Breivoll gård. On Thursday morning, transport is arranged from Breivoll gård to the NMBU. After lunch, transport will be arranged to the train station.

Accommodation:

Rooms have been pre-booked at the farm and guesthouse "Breivoll gård" <u>Breivoll Gård (ut.no)</u> in Bunnefjorden. The farm is related to the Norwegian Tourist society and thus having simple but good services for a good night rest. There are rooms for 2, 3 og 5 persons and the toilets and bathroom facilities are adjacent to these. The price for one bed (not a room) and breakfast is 1000 NOK pp. This needs to be paid by each participant itself at the farm. Please inform us at registration if you want to book a bed.

With regard to lunch and dinner, these will be kindly sponsored by Geno and SpermVital. Dinner will be arranged at Breivoll gård on Wednesday evening. Transport will be arranged from the NMBU to the farm after the meeting.
